KIDS/KEDS Submission Overview

Overview

The 2026–2027 school year will serve as the transition year from the Kansas Individual Data on Students (KIDS) system to the Kansas Education Data System (KEDS). During the beginning of the school year, districts will continue using KIDS for several key collections while KEDS is implemented for other functions.

The following KIDS collections will remain in use during the initial transition period:

- **ASGT (Assignment)** – Districts will continue submitting ASGT records all year to establish ("claim") student enrollment and to obtain State Student Identifiers (SSIDs) for new students.
- **ENRL (Enrollment)** – ENRL records submitted for the September 20 funding count will continue to be collected in KIDS and will serve as the official source of truth for school finance purposes.
- **EXIT** – EXIT records will continue to be submitted through November 1. The Dropout Graduation Summary Report (DGSR) will remain open for corrections through October 31. Following the closure of the DGSR correction window, KSDE plans to discontinue the collection of EXIT records in KIDS.
- **MILT (Military Funding)** - MILT records submitted for the February 20 funding count will continue to be collected in KIDS and will serve as the official source of truth for school finance purposes.

After the September 20 enrollment count and the DGSR correction window have concluded, KSDE plans to complete the transition to KEDS for student data collections. Additional guidance, timelines, and implementation details will be communicated throughout the summer and fall as the transition progresses.

Please note that some collections and functions will be available **only in KEDS** during the fall of 2026. For example, **assessment rostering** will be managed through KEDS. The **Fall Dyslexia Screener** results will be collected exclusively in KEDS.

Data Collection Types

ASGT Records

ASGT records uploaded to the KIDS Collection System will still be used to allow staff to obtain identification numbers called State Student Identifiers (SSID) for new students and update student data for existing students. These records can be sent at any time for the 2026-2027 school year.

Course Information (TASC and KCAN records)

Course information for all courses for the 2026-2027 school year will be collected through the KEDS system. Course information will include course offerings, staff section association, student section association, and grades (when available). Session, grading period, course offerings with state course codes, staff section association, and student section association information should be submitted at the beginning of the year and maintained throughout the year.

Signing up students to take interim assessments, mini-test administration, and optional 2nd grade Reading assessment will take place through the KEDS system. In order for students to be sent to KITE, staff section association and student section association data need to be submitted to KEDS.

ENRL Records

The ENRL funding collection will be collected through both KIDS and KEDS. The data submitted through KIDS will be used to fund schools for the 2026-2027 school year. The data collected through KEDS will be used to validate that the KEDS data can make the same calculations. Both sets of data will be displayed in the Principal's Building Report (PBR) and Superintendent's Organization Report (SO66) for you to review. The ENRL window for KIDS will be September 21, 2026 – October 10, 2026. A snapshot will be taken of the KEDS data after October 10, 2026.

EXIT Records

EXIT information for the 2025-2026 Exit year (October 1, 2025-September 31, 2026) needs to be submitted in the KIDS Collection system and the KEDS system. Only the EXIT records submitted in the KIDS System will be used in the DGSR for the 2025-2026 school year.

Assessment Rostering

The information collected on TEST records to order student summative assessments will be collected in the KEDS system. More information on how this will work will be available later.

Students that will be taking one of the cPASS assessments (Comprehensive Agriculture, Plant Systems, or Animal Systems) will be ordered using the KEDS system. This information is submitted to KEDS using the Student Assessment resource.

SMSC Records

The enrollment counts collected on SMSC records will be collected in the KEDS system only. Student data should be current as of December 1, 2026

MILT Records

The MILT funding collection will be collected through KIDS and KEDS. The data submitted through KIDS will be used to fund schools for the 2026-2027 school year to align with data submitted through ENRL. The data collected through KEDS will be used to validate that the

KEDS data can make the same calculations. The MILT window for KIDS will be February 22, 2027 – March 11, 2027. A snapshot will be taken of the KEDS data after March 11, 2027.

EOYA Records

The current plan is to collect the end of year data only through the KEDS system. This decision will be finalized in late 2026. Once the decision is finalized the collection plan and correction window will be announced.

SPED Records

SPED records are a KIDS Collection only collection. There is currently no KED replacement for this functionality.

QUERY Records

QUERY records are a KIDS Collection only collection. Similar functionality will be available when the Student Lookup Tool is released in Fall 2026.

Dyslexia Screener Scores

Recently passed legislation, (Kansas House Bill 2485), requires several changes to the Kansas dyslexia universal screener reporting requirements. Fall and Spring screener scores will now be collected in KEDS only using the Student Assessment resource. The deadline for the Fall screener score collection is October 10, 2026.
